

The **Mid-East Texas Groundwater Conservation District** ("District") will hold a Public Hearing to consider a Water Well Drilling Permit application submitted by the City of Fairfield to drill a new water well in Freestone County. The proposed location of the well is Latitude 31.728304° North and Longitude -96.150637° West, at 300 Love Street. The beneficial use for this groundwater will be for Public Water Supply. Production is proposed from the Hooper layer of the Wilcox aquifer at a proposed depth of 735 feet. The proposed production rate is 500 gallons per minute. If approved, production from this water well will be included in Operating Permit #FR-2012-002.

This Water Well Drilling Permit Application will be considered by the Board of Directors of the District at a Regular Meeting/Public Hearing to be held **Thursday, October 27, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. at the Freestone County Courthouse in Fairfield, Texas**. This meeting is open to the public and anyone wishing to make comments regarding the Water Well Drilling Permit may do so at a time designated by the Board of Directors. The application has been deemed administratively complete and staff is recommending the application be approved. Protests regarding this application must be filed by 5:00 pm on October 26, 2022.
