

The **Mid-East Texas Groundwater Conservation District** ("District") will hold a Public Hearing to consider a Water Well Drilling Permit application submitted by Texas Department of Criminal Justice (TDCJ) – Ferguson Unit to drill a new water well in Madison County. The proposed location of the well is Latitude 30.705561° North and Longitude -95.705561° West, approximately 5.04 miles southeast of Midway, TX at 12120 Savage Dr. The beneficial use for this groundwater will be for Public Water Supply. Production is proposed from the Sparta aquifer at a proposed depth of 1,490 feet. The proposed production rate is 700 gallons per minute. If approved, production from this water well will be included in Operating Permit #MA-2011-004. The proposed new well will be used as redundancy with no additional groundwater requested.

This Water Well Drilling Permit Application will be considered by the Board of Directors of the District at a Regular Meeting/Public Hearing to be held **Tuesday, April 27, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. at the Madison County Courthouse in Madisonville, Texas**. This meeting is open to the public and anyone wishing to make comments regarding the Water Well Drilling Permit may do so at a time designated by the Board of Directors. Social distancing will be observed.
